You may pay by mail, internet or telephone banking, drop box at the Municipal Office and pre-authorized installment or monthly payments. In an effort to become more efficient in processing Property Tax and Sewer/Water Bills, the Municipality is offering residents and businesses the opportunity to receive tax, water or sewer bills by email as opposed to regular mail. HOW TO SUBMIT YOUR ACHIEVEMENT CERTIFICATE REQUEST



SIDEWALK AND ROAD PROJECTS

There are a number of sidewalk revitalization projects underway in the municipality, highlighted on these maps. Work will be completed in Chesley by the end of July, in Paisley by the end of June, and Tara's has been completed. Projects can be seen in further detail on our website. Road work can also be expected in following areas:

- Sideroad 15 South Elderslie, road will divert around river to Concession 10
- · Reconstruction of Hamilton Street, Tara
- Paving of Industrial Road, Chesley and Albert St, Paisley
- Tar and chip on Brant-Elderslie boundary road
- Micro surface treatment on Concession 10, Elderslie (from Sideroad 15-20)

BRIDGEWORK UPDATE

Teeswater River Bridge is planned to open this fall. More details, including a projected timeline can be found at www.brucecounty.on.ca


The municipality is working on street reconstruction while the bridge repair is underway.

The municipality is also starting to develop a **Bridge Master Plan.** A public meeting will be scheduled in September to discuss options for some of the oldest bridges in the municipality.

NEW FIRE HALL FOR PAISLEY

A new Fire Hall has been announced for Paisley. Council has approved the site location at the west side of Queen St. S between Balaklava St. and Canrobert St. The Paisley Firehall Subcommittee is working on finalizing the design concept.

Preparation of the site for construction is planned to happen during 2023 and building construction to commence in 2024.




